**SUBJECT: NAMIBIA CHANGES TO SUMMER TIME ON SUNDAY, 6 SEPTEMBER 2016**

At 02:00 on Sunday, 4 September 2016, Namibians have to turn their clocks forward one hour to enter summer time, which is two hours in advance of Greenwich Mean Time.

This practice is in accordance with the Namibian Time Act, Act No. 3 of 1994, which regulates winter and summer time in Namibia. The Act stipulates that Namibia enters summer time at 02:00 on the first Sunday in September of every year and reverts to winter time at 02:00 on the first Sunday of April every year.

It would be appreciated if the media can remind Namibians of the time change.
